### San Diego, the Site of the 2012 National LICA Winter Convention

San Diego is famous for its perfect climate, 70 miles of pristine beaches and many attractions that include the San Diego Zoo, Sea World San Diego and LEGOLAND. San Diego offers an expansive variety of things to see and do, appealing to all LICA Members and their families.

California's second largest city and the United States' eighth largest, San Diego has a population of almost 1.3 million. Within its borders of 4,200 sq. miles, San Diego County encompasses 18 incorporated cities and numerous other charming neighborhoods and communities, including downtown's historic Gaslamp Quarter, Little Italy, Coronado, La Jolla, Del Mar, Carlsbad, and Chula Vista just to name a few.

On the USS Midway LICA members will uncover almost 50 years of history. The Midway is the longest-serving Navy aircraft of the 20th century, from 1945 until 1992 she sailed all seven seas. Named after the Battle of Midway, she fought in Vietnam and the first Persian Gulf War.

### **CONTRACTORS ENCOURAGE A HIGHWAY BILL NOW!**

The Land Improvement Contractors of America (LICA) is urging its members and voters throughout the nation to be vocal in urging Congress to enact an adequately funded transportation bill now! "This fall is a critical time for our industry to remind all federal elected officials of the dire situation our highways and the construction industry are facing," said Jerry Biuso, LICA CEO. "We need to keep the pressure on Congress to do what is needed to make highways and other elements of our surface transportation system a top priority."

Biuso believes promoting a bill is particularly important this summer for several reasons:

- Our nation's economy continues to falter, and with the continuing economic uncertainty,unemployment remains at a critical level in the construction industry. Passage of the highway bill would create and sustain well-paying, long-term jobs for people who want and need to work.
- Summertime means that with school recesses and vacations large groups of people will visit Washington, DC. This means elected officials will hear from many special interests at this time. We must ensure that transportation needs not get lost in the summer discussion of other issues.
- August is also the time when Senators and Representatives return home to their states and districts.

This gives voters more opportunities to have direct contact with these elected officials on their home turf. There are opportunities to press our ideas at town hall meetings, fundraising and campaign events, and town festivals.

- August 10th marks the sixth anniversary of the signing of the most recent highway bill, which since its expiration has been extended seven times. With no clear timeline for the next transportation bill, it is difficult, if not impossible, for many contracting businesses to invest in the future.
- Fuel prices are also rising at an alarming rate. With motorists paying close to \$4 a gallon for gasoline, and some officials suggesting even higher prices, we can scarcely afford to waste fuel because of the inefficiency and disrepair of our nation's highways.

"Our ability to move people and goods is critical to the United States," Biuso says. "Our federal government has underinvested in maintaining our nation's transportation infrastructure for years. Even in these tough economic times, with government spending cuts needed, it is time to set some priorities for what is needed here at home, and spend less throughout the world. Accounting for inflation, we spend less on our infrastructure today than we did in 1975. This is simply unacceptable. We need to make this summer one of action and not just another time of inaction."
